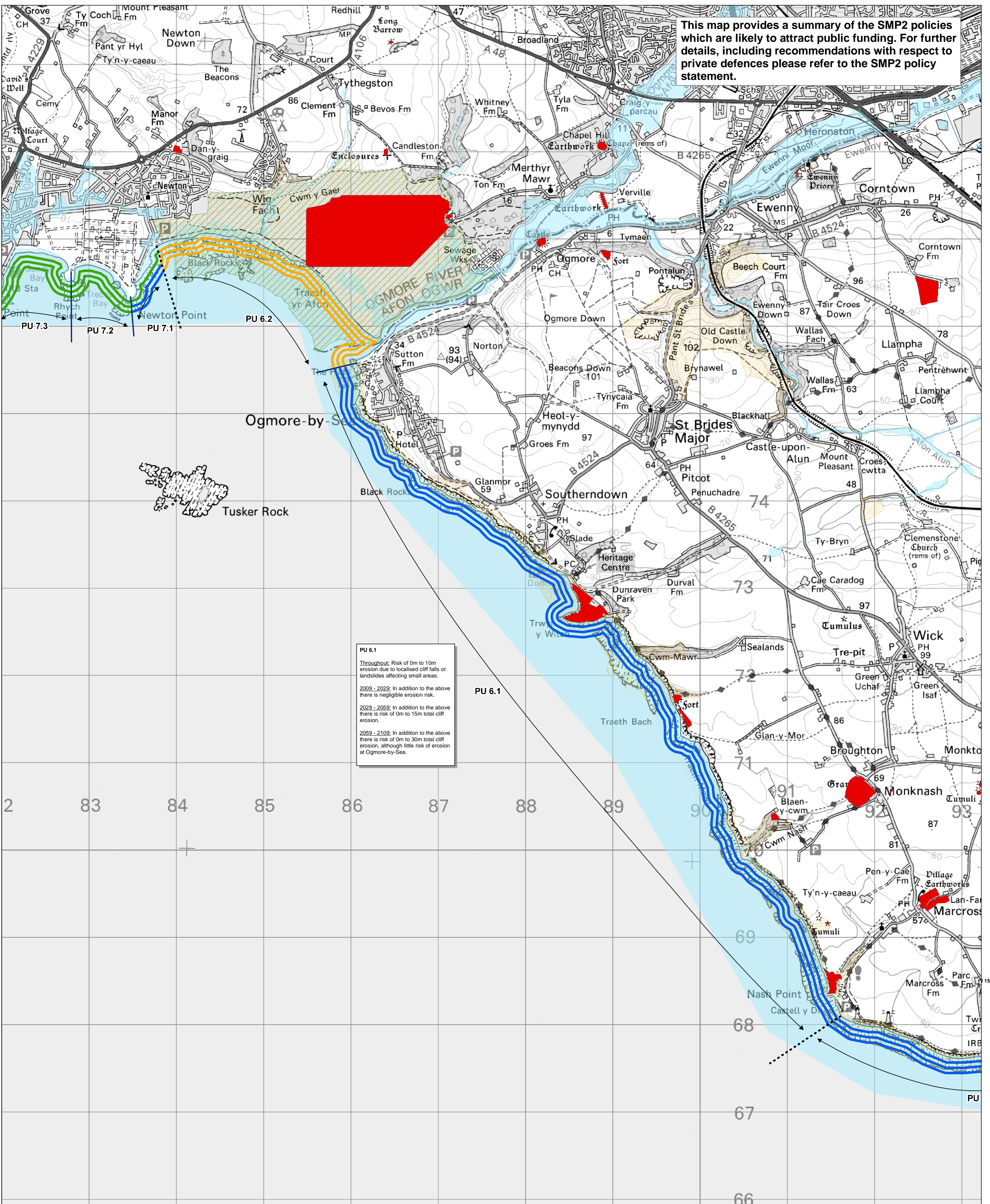


This map provides a summary of the SMP2 policies which are likely to attract public funding. For further details, including recommendations with respect to private defences please refer to the SMP2 policy statement.



PU 6.1
 Throughout; Risk of 0m to 10m erosion due to localised cliff falls or landslides affecting small areas.
 2009 - 2029; In addition to the above there is negligible erosion risk.
 2029 - 2059; In addition to the above there is risk of 0m to 15m total cliff erosion.
 2059 - 2109; In addition to the above there is risk of 0m to 30m total cliff erosion, although little risk of erosion at Ogmore-by-Sea.

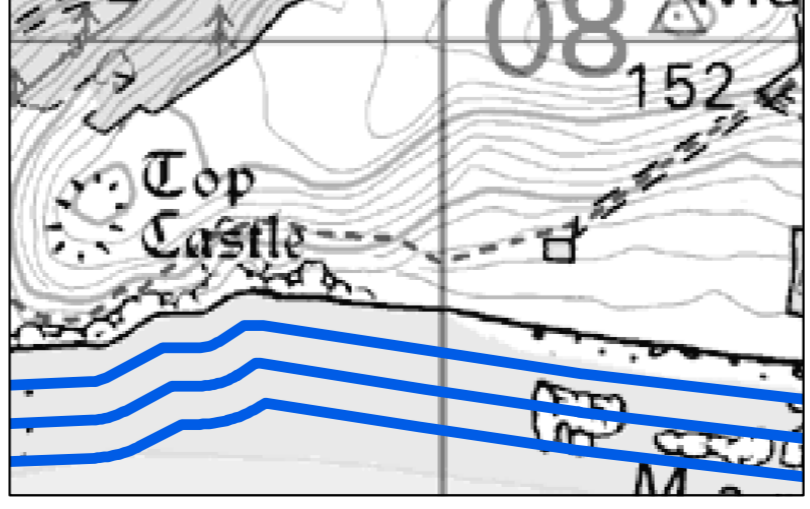
